



STUDY TECHNIQUES:

ELABORATIVE INTERROGATION



The key to using it successfully:

Works best with a friend. And talk out loud!



Elaborative interrogation is just a fancy term for asking "Why?". This helps your brain understand causes and effects.



Pose a question. After the answer, ask "Why?". Keep asking "why" after each question until you have a thorough understanding of the issue.



Answer out loud! By talking through an issue, your brain gets the information by hearing it. Get as many senses involved as you can.
