Northern State University is pleased to share with you the following information about student achievement in graduate-level programs. While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind.

- Each academic year spans three academic terms, starting with the summer and ending with the spring.
- Students counted in a particular cohort were first-time graduate students during the summer, fall, or spring term of that year. Both full-time and part-time students are included.
- Students are considered retained if they attend during a term within the next year, ignoring the subsequent term. For example, a student who starts during a fall term will be considered retained if he/she also attends the next summer or fall term.
