Updating to remove additional 41-42 general education requirements and correct credit distribution. Makes transparent formerly hidden credits in applied music. Creates a Music Technology emphasis that overlaps with Northern's existing BA in Digital Media.

Free electives enable students to choose a minor and/or a certificate that will better prepare students with transferable skills.
