Updates to the program include a Math Clinic Practicum (ELED 495) and a Social Science Content and Curricular Knowledge course (ELED 420/520). The Math Clinic Practicum offers teacher candidates an additional field experience specific to math instruction. The Social Science Content and Curricular Knowledge course provides additional content and curricular information for preservice and in-service teachers. The program modification will exchange these 3 credits for 3 of the 10 currently available elective credits in the Elementary Education program, thus increasing the total program credits.
