The proposed new course in responding to the social-emotional and behavioral needs of young children is different from the existing courses (EEC 322 and ECE 328/328L) in that it provides much more specific emphases on the development of emotional intelligence and interpersonal skills young children need to engage in positive relationships and help them learn self-regulation skills, while providing students the opportunity to learn crucial behavior management and de-escalation techniques and strategies needed in current early childhood educational settings such as daycares and preschools. Child Guidance/Classroom Environment and Guidance with Young Children are much broader in terms of solely focusing on child observation and guidance techniques.
