## 6. Provide a brief rationale for the new prefix below:

Northern State University offers a First Year Seminar course that is required of all new students within every major program. The current IDL prefix does not align with the purposes and content of our First Year Seminar. Surveys of students who completed our HOWL orientation reveal that students are confused about the purpose of this course they are all required to take. Evidence suggests that this confusion is due in part to the mismatch between the content and purpose of the course and the prefix and catalog description students find in our university literature. By using a prefix that matches the actual course, as well as a clearer description, which is being proposed

alongside this new prefix request, our students will have greater clarity regarding the benefits of taking the required First Year Seminar and will consequently find the course more rewarding.
