The course description for SEED 395 and SEED 396 generally summarizes a field experience in education. The proposed course more closely aligns with the apprenticeship pathway, emphasizing experiential learning and reflective practice, preparing aspiring educators for the dynamic challenges of the teaching profession while working as a paraprofessional in a school. While there is oversight from a field experience supervisor in SEED 395 and 396, the proposed course focuses more on the unique relationship of teacher mentor and apprentice in addition to contextual experiential learning.
