This course provides advanced research and program evaluation within counseling, emphasizing culturally responsive and ethical methodologies, evidence-based practice, and advocacy. Additionally, it prepares students to design and evaluate counseling interventions with a strong emphasis on cultural competence, statistical literacy, and the direct application of research to improve counseling services and advocacy efforts. 3 credits
