Northern State University is seeking authority to offer courses under the Career and Technical Education (CTE) prefix to address the growing demand for qualified CTE teachers in South Dakota and the surrounding region. As schools expand career readiness and technical education programs, the need for licensed CTE educators continues to rise, particularly in rural areas experiencing persistent shortages. NSU plans to launch a Bachelor of Science in Education in Career and Technical Education to provide a clear pathway for individuals—including those transitioning from industry careers—to earn certification and develop essential instructional skills. Offering CTE-prefix courses will ensure alignment with state standards and better prepare future educators to meet the workforce development needs of the region.
