Demonstrates safe, efficient practice in the clinical setting. Emphasis is placed on components of geriatric care, therapeutic communication, cultural and spiritual care, and ethical standards. Students will develop entry-level organizational and time management skills in the clinical setting and perform psychomotor skills with clients. Corequisites: NURS 239/L and NURS 269/L.
