Reinforces beginning and intermediate nursing psychomotor skills and further develops advanced skills while demonstrating safe, efficient care in the hospital and community setting. Co-requisites: NURS 333, NURS 369, and NURS 379/L. Pre-requisites: NURS 238, NURS 239/L, NURS 269/L, NURS 327, NURS 328, NURS 329/L, and NURS 355.
