Course Description

Focuses on health promotion and patient teaching while caring primarily for the child or adult with complex acute and chronic physiological or behavioral health conditions. This course provides the opportunity to master beginning and intermediate nursing psychomotor skills and further reinforces advanced skills while demonstrating safe, efficient care in complex health care settings. Co-requisites: NURS 459 and NURS 467. Pre-requisites: NURS 238, NURS 239/L, NURS 269/L, NURS 327, NURS 328, NURS 329/L, NURS 333, NURS 355, NURS 369, NURS 378, and NURS 379/L.
