Previous knowledge is synthesized and content on conflict management, group process, fiduciary responsibility, and developing a personal leadership style are included. Co-requisite: NURS 458 and NURS 467. Pre-requisites: NURS 238, NURS 239/L, NURS 329/L, NURS 327, NURS 328, NURS 329/L, NURS 333, NURS 355, NURS 369, NURS 378, and NURS 379/L.
