2.2.	Add	<i>justification</i>	for all	changes	noted above

The current structure of the teacher education program at NSU includes a significant number of required courses, leading to a heavy credit load for students. In response to these academic demands, we propose changing PE 330 from a fixed 2-credit course to a 1-2 variable credit course. This change will better accommodate the diverse needs of our students while maintaining the integrity of the course content and objectives.

Many institutions have recognized the benefits of variable credit courses, allowing for greater flexibility and adaptability in course offerings. Aligning PE 330 with this model demonstrates our commitment to modernizing our curriculum in response to evolving educational trends and best practices. It positions our program as forward-thinking and responsive to student needs, which is crucial for attracting and retaining quality candidates in teacher education.

Changing PE 330 to a variable credit format does not imply a reduction in the quality or rigor of the course. The course will continue to adhere to the established learning outcomes and objectives, ensuring that all students receive a comprehensive education in physical education. Instructors can maintain high standards while providing varied credit options, thus upholding the integrity of the program.

Both USD and NSU agree to move forward with this proposal.
