This course is distinct from CJUS 207 – Introduction to Homeland Security (NSU) and CJUS 442 – National Security Policy (USD) because it investigates extremist movements and domestic terrorism through a social scientific and theoretical framework. While those courses emphasize organizational structures, policies, and institutional practices, this seminar examines how such elements intersect with economic, political, historical, and psychological forces. It focuses on understanding the rationales that drive extremism and terrorism, exploring how they emerge, evolve, and gain traction within broader societal contexts.
