Admissions Requirements:

1. Apply to NSU - <https://apply.northern.edu/apply/>

- Minimum of 2.6 Grade Point Average (GPA) to be accepted.
- Can also be accepted with - ACT of 18 or SAT 960 (not required)

2. Submit the following documents to international@northern.edu

- Official high school transcript
- Copy of passport
- Declaration of finance form
- Bank statement that shows proof of \$25,895
- Immunization form
- English Proficiency Exam Score (not required for English-speaking countries)
 - TOEFL 61 or higher
 - 5.5 IELTS or higher
 - 90 Duolingo or higher

Cost Breakdown: International degree-seekers pay the following.

Tuition - \$367.60 per credit

- 12 to 15 credits = \$4,412 - \$5,514 per semester = \$12,057 including fees

Fees

- Application Fee - \$20
- I-901 Fee - \$350 (paid to US Embassy, required to schedule F1 Visa Appointment)
- SEVIS Charge - \$300 (refundable upon arrival to campus)
- General Activity Fee - \$40.95 per credit
 - 12 to 15 credits = \$491.40 - \$614.25
- International Student Fee - \$200 per semester
- Exam Fee - \$91 per course
- Discipline Fees – Based on the educational program.
 - Business - \$30.35
 - Science - \$21.20
 - Computer Science - \$47.70
 - Math, Statistics, Fine Arts - \$15.90
 - Counseling - \$26.35

- Professional Education Fee – Per Semester
 - Sophomore/Junior Field Experience - \$176
 - Senior Field Experience - \$352

 - Email signed I-20 to michael.mohammed@northern.edu
3. Pay I-901 fee - \$350
4. Schedule a VISA interview at United States Embassy in home country
5. Upon VISA approval, schedule flight for the start of semester orientation
