The USD course ARTH 517 is not designed only for graduate students. It is dual listed at the 400/500 level. NASD guidelines for master's programs in art education stress the importance of only graduate students being enrolled in the art history courses required for the program. As a 700-level course, only graduate students will be enrolled in ARTH 715. Additionally, ARTH 517 focuses only on print making, and ARTH 715 is more comprehensive.
