The USD course ARTH 516 is not designed only for graduate students. It is dual listed at the 400/500 level. NASD guidelines for master's programs in art education stress the importance of only graduate students being enrolled in the art history courses required for the program. As a 700-level course, only graduate students will be enrolled in ARTH 716.

The USD course ARTH 712 is designated as an independent study with 1 student enrolled at a time in a directed readings program. Northern's ARTH 716 will be a lecture/discussion style course with 10-20 students enrolled.
