

High School College Prep Dual Credit Program – Spring 2018

Northern State University

Thank you for your interest in the Northern State University College Prep Dual Credit Program through the South Dakota Board of Regents (SDBOR) in partnership with the SD Department of Education and the South Dakota Education Access Foundation (SDEAF). Northern is offering remedial English, Math, and Reading courses meeting the SDBOR system remedial education requirements. High school juniors/seniors attending a public high school within South Dakota eligible for or receiving free/reduced lunch may be eligible to participate in this program and receive both high school and college credit at **NO COST**. The student's tuition and textbooks fees are paid by a grant from SDEAF.

Admission Requirements:

High school junior/senior eligible to enroll in a high school in South Dakota eligible for/receiving free/reduced lunch with a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.25 or higher and meets one or more of the following requirements:

- a. Place for MATH 095 –
 - Math Index (MI) 1149 or lower
 - ACCUPLACER Elementary Algebra 75 or lower
 - Smarter Balanced 2627 or lower
- b. Place for ENGL 033 – and/or
 - ACT 17 or lower
 - ACCUPLACER Sentence Skills 85 or lower
 - Smarter Balanced 2582 or lower
- c. Place for READ 041
 - ACT 17 or lower
 - ACCUPLACER Reading 84 or lower

Application Period and Deadline:

Applications for Spring 2018 will start being accepted on November 20, 2017.

Applications must be received on campus BEFORE the Close of Business on the first day of the semester in which you are enrolling. (Spring 2018 Semester: January 8, 2018*). Applications received on campus after this date will not be considered. Please note that students registering near the deadline may encounter some difficulties related to class availability, course materials, etc. It is in the best interest of students to apply early, as an indication of interest does not guarantee future enrollment.
