COMMENTS & NOTES

Program Overview:

The Department of Nursing offers two admission pathways: the Standard option every Spring semester and the Fast Path option every Fall semester. Both options are completed in five semesters, with the Fast Path offering a continuous path to graduation, including a summer semester.

Admission Requirements

Students must apply and be accepted to the Nursing major prior to enrolling in most NURS courses (exceptions: NURS 285 and NURS 327). Admission is competitive and based on a holistic review process that considers academics, life experiences, healthcare background, interview performance, and other factors. Meeting minimum criteria does not guarantee admission into the major.

Minimum requirements:

- GPA of 2.7 or higher
- Grade of C or higher in all pre-nursing courses & courses required for completion of the BSN degree
- Students may repeat prerequisite courses, but if a grade of "C" is not earned within 2 attempts, the student will not be eligible for admission

After acceptance into the Nursing major, additional health and safety clearances are required before beginning the program.

Important Notes

Students should always consult with their advisor before completing their schedules. Taking incorrect courses can alter your pathway and impact your ability to progress in the program on schedule. Some course substitutions may be allowed but require authorization and additional documentation.
