Nursing Credit Transfer (NURS 391: Independent Study LPN Transition Course required)

To be eligible for nursing credit transfer, students must possess an active LPN license, maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, and have documentation of 1000+ hours of direct patient care experience as a licensed LPN within the previous two years. Additionally, all bridge students are required to complete NURS 391: LPN to BSN Bridge Course with a "B" before credits will be awarded

COMMENTS & NOTES

Program Overview:

The LPN-to-BSN Pathway provides Licensed Practical Nurses with a streamlined route to earning a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. Total time to degree varies based on prerequisite and general education coursework still needed to meet program admission requirements and fulfill baccalaureate degree completion.

Admission Requirements to the LPN to BSN Pathway

- Active, unencumbered LPN license
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Minimum of 1000 hours of direct patient care within the preceding two years
- Grade of C or higher in all pre-nursing courses & courses required for completion of the BSN degree
- Completion of NURS 391: LPN to BSN Bridge course with a grade of B
- Completion of NURS 327: Pathophysiology with a grade of C

Important Notes

Students should always consult with their advisor before completing their schedules. Taking incorrect courses can alter your pathway and impact your ability to progress in the program on schedule. Some course substitutions may be allowed but require authorization and additional documentation.
