<p>Certification in Adaptive Physical Education (CAPE) requires nine credits specific to adapted physical activity courses and 200 hours of contact time with students with disabilities. Changing the course to a three-credits allows for thirty of the 200-hour requirement to be met. Additionally, changing the course to a three-credits allows for more detailed instruction/application of motor/sport skills for individuals with disabilities.</p> <p>Offering this course as part of the Major requirements for Human Performance and Sport Marketing &amp; Administration, this meets the diversity standard for the Council on Sport Management Accreditation curriculum standards.</p> <p>Removing the pre-requisite of PE 352 – Adapted Physical Education because information in PE 352 is not needed as foundational material.</p>
