This course is an overview of the components to providing ethical psychological treatment. Historical cases, such as the Stanford Prison Experiment, the Tuskegee Study, and the Milgram Study, will be examined to determine how psychological ethics have changed over the years. In addition, students will get an introduction to current psychological ethical standards. Students will also complete the CITI Human Subjects ethical training during the course.
