- Relax at the Hobbitenango dream village, disconnect from the busy world and reconnect with friends and nature
- Build a bottle school in a municipal of San Martín Jilotepeque
- Take community hike, meet the locals, visit the home of a few local producers
- Learn about the Guatemalan culture, people, history and civil war
- Visit Mayan ruins of Ch'w'a Nim Ab'ä'j, the last Kaqchikel fortress conquered by the Spaniards and enjoy an eye-opening tour led by an expert guide Dimas
- Visit the School for Children with Special Needs
- Explore beautiful Antigua, a UNESCO World Heritage City, known for its preserved Spanish Baroque-influenced architecture and rich history
- Visit the artisan markets, museums, galleries, churches and sites of historical interest

ESTIMATED COST: \$2,700

Price includes round trip travel from Aberdeen, 9 days in Guatemala, most meals, all hotel stays, entrance fees and cultural programs, all transportation, guides and translators. Out of pocket expenses: \$145 passport, \$100 meals not included in program, \$200 personal expenses. Scholarships are available for this program.
